Grant	Based on a true story about Lee Israel, a celebrity biographer, who finds a creative, but illegal, way to pay her bills. <i>It's interesting but parts of it are unpleasant and depressing to watch because of her rudeness and bad temper, coupled with her circumstances. I recommend TCM tonight.</i>
<u>Good Karma Hospital</u> 2017-2019: 1h 46m	Drama	Amanda Redman, Amrita Acharia, James Floyd	Mini-series about a young female doctor, in need of a distraction, takes a job in India in an overcrowded and underfunded hospital. <i>Engaging story.</i>
 <u>If Beale Street Could Talk</u> 2018: 1h 59m	Drama, Crime R (48+ profanity; sexual content)	Regina King, Kiki Layne, Stephan James	Some residents wanted to see this film after Regina King won an Oscar for her role as the mother of a young pregnant woman in Harlem trying to navigate the justice system to free her fiancé. <i>It's a slow-moving film with lots of montages and flashbacks. Please read poster for R-rated content.</i>
<u>Inside Europe</u> 2019: 2 parts (90 min.ea)	Documentary	Corbin Bleu, Lora Lee Gayer, Bryce Pinkham,	This two-part BBC documentary was selected because some residents wanted to learn more about Brexit and the European Union. This doc highlights the challenges of keeping the European Union together. It spans the period from 2008 to 2018.
<u>Mrs. Wilson</u> 2019: 2 parts (90 min.ea)	Biography, Drama, Mystery	Ruth Wilson, Fiona Shaw, Iain Glen	A two-part series based on a true story about a grieving widow who discovers that her seemingly ideal husband had a secret life.
<u>Saving Mr. Banks</u> 2014: 2h 5m	Biography, Drama, Comedy PG-13	Emma Thompson, Tom Hanks, Paul Giamatti	Interesting film about how Walt Disney came to make Mary Poppins. It centers on the books' author, P.L. Travers, and her Australian childhood.
<u>A Simple Favor</u> 2018: 1h 57m	Mystery, Comedy R (90+ profanity)	Anna Kendrick, Blake Lively, Henry Golding	A mother disappears after asking for help from another mother. <i>This is not a Hitchcock or a Film Noir but it is a whodunit that will keep you guessing until the end. Quirky and dark humour lightens the suspense. Criticism: Excessive profanity was unnecessary.</i>
<u>Spitfire</u> 2018: 1h 39m	Documentary	Geoffrey Wellum, Mary Ellis	A documentary about the RAF fighter plane and pilots that helped win the Battle of Britain in World War II.
